

Frequently Asked Questions

How much does the shuttle bus cost?

An adult day ticket costs just £4, for travel between Newark and Newark Showground as much as you want, in both directions. A group of up to four people (travelling together) can travel all day for just £9. If you've got a free bus pass (with an orange or blue stripe on) you can't travel for free on this service, but you do travel for a discounted price of £2.50.

Who is the shuttle bus operated by?

The Nottinghamshire County Show shuttle bus is operated by Vectare, a local bus and coach operator.

What colour bus should I be expecting?

Look out for one of our silver Mercedes-Benz Sprinter minibuses, which will have our logo on the side. The electronic sign on the front of the bus will display "Nottinghamshire County Show Shuttle Bus".

How many spaces are on the bus? And is it pushchair/wheelchair friendly?

There are 16 seats on the bus and the bus is pushchair/wheelchair friendly (limited to one pushchair and wheelchair at a time).

Can I get to Nottinghamshire County Show from Nottingham / Bingham / Farndon by bus?

Yes! Catch our bus number 90 (vectare.co.uk/90) to Bus Station, Bay A in Newark, and change to the County Show shuttle bus at the same bus stop.

I'm coming to Newark by train, where can I catch the shuttle bus from?

If you're arriving into Newark Castle railway station, walk towards the town centre (towards the castle, over the bridge over the river). Turn left at the roundabout and catch the shuttle bus from the Kirk Gate bus stop.

If you're arriving into Newark Northgate railway station the shuttle bus will pick up and drop off from the bus stop just outside the front of the station.
