Articles of Association, By-Laws & Regulations

The organisation of the Nottinghamshire County Show is under the control of a Council.

The Show is held under the Articles of Association, By-Laws and Regulations of the Newark & Nottinghamshire Agricultural Society, which accordingly binds all exhibitors and others attending the Show.

The attention of exhibitors is drawn to the Show Regulations and Information printed in this Schedule and to the conditions from the respective Breed Societies at the start of each section. Copies of the Articles of Association, By-Laws and Regulations are held in the Society Office.

The Society reserves the right to postpone or cancel the Show, or any particular section or event, if such cancellation, postponement arises out of strikes, lock-outs, trade disputes or labour problems, or any other cause beyond the control of the Society, including, but without limitation, Act of God, Governmental Act Regulation or request, fire, accident, war, riot or inability to obtain adequate labour, materials or sufficient number of entries.

The Schedule is issued subject to the Orders & Advice of DEFRA - The Department for Environment, Food & Rural Affairs, and any Local Authorities which may be operative at the time of the Show.

Day of Attendance:

Exhibitors who wish to be judged **must** attend on Saturday when vehicles will be judged and trophies awarded. There will be no judging on Sunday. Exhibitors are welcome to attend on either Saturday or Sunday or both days; but **must** indicate their choice on the entry form. Due to restricted space, the Society reserves the right to refuse an entry if any particular class is full.

All Exhibitors are asked to use their best endeavours to be parked up in the Rally compound by **8.30am**. Due to Health and Safety requirements the Show access gates will be locked shortly after this time and no vehicles of any sort will be allowed to move onto the Showground for reasons of public safety.

On entering the compound, exhibitors must report to the Steward's Office in order to be given a self-judging slip and shown where to park. All vehicles will have been sent an entry number card. This must be displayed on the vehicle at all times for the benefit of the public and so that judging can take place.

Exhibits will be judged by 12.00 noon on Saturday. In the case of a Judge being undecided as to the winning exhibitor in any class, the Chief Steward will have the casting vote for first place.

Prizes

Trophies will be awarded for the first place in each class as indicated below. Rosettes will be awarded for the first and second in each class.

Trophies will be presented at 3.00pm on Saturday at the Sponsor's Stand in the corner of the Rally compound.

Leaving the Rally

Vehicles may leave the Showground either under the Stewards' control at 4.30pm or will have to remain until 6.30pm when it is judged that the majority of the public will have exited the Showground. For safety reasons no vehicle may leave it's parked position in the Rally compound until the Stewards have indicated it is safe to do so.

By entering the Rally, all exhibitors undertake that they have read and understood these conditions.

There is NO ENTRY FEE for this Rally.

Entry

All Exhibitors are asked to use their best endeavours to be parked up in the Rally compound by 8.30am. Exit

Vehicles may leave the Showground either under the Stewards' control at 4.30pm or will have to remain until 6.30pm when it is judged that the majority of the public will have exited the Showground. For safety reasons no vehicle may leave it's parked position in the Rally compound until the Stewards have indicated it is safe to do so.

REGULATIONS & INFORMATION

Please observe the following for the smooth running of the Show, your safety and enjoyment of all who visit the Show in any capacity

1. **Closing Date of Entries**

Entries close Friday 7th April 2017

It may be necessary to close entries before the advertised date therefore entries should be made as soon as possible. Entries will not be accepted on the Show day.

2. **Restriction on Vehicles in each Class**

The right is reserved by the Military Exhibits Committee to restrict the number of entries in each of the classes.

3. **Refusal of Entries**

The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry without assigning any reason.

4. **Responsibility**

Exhibitors participate in this Rally at their own risk, as the Newark & Nottinghamshire Agricultural Society cannot be held responsible for any loss, damage or accident however caused. It is therefore recommended that exhibitors hold an Insurance Policy.

5. **Vehicle Passes & General Information**

All passes and information will be dispatched approximately 14 days prior to the Show. Each vehicle entered will be allocated a Numbered Exhibitor Card which will admit the driver of the vehicle plus one passenger onto the showground: this should be filled in neatly and all the Vehicle information should be complete. **Drivers are asked to display their exhibitor number clearly on their vehicle once parked up, to aid judging. If a vehicle cannot be identified because no entry number is displayed, it will not be judged.**

Please note: admission tickets issued to exhibitors can only be used in the Vehicle Rally Compound entrance (no admittance will be given to pedestrians at the general public entrance gates).

6. Extra Admission Tickets

Exhibitors in all sections may purchase extra admission tickets for the days of the Show at 'Advance' price if application and payment are made at the time of making an entry.

Please note: All tickets ordered with the submission of entries will be dispatched with the Exhibitor Tickets approximately 14 days prior to the start of the Show.

7. Tender Vehicles

No tender vehicles will be allowed to park in the Rally Compound due to the lack of space. Parking for tender vehicles will be provided and stewards will direct exhibitors to this area.

8. Substitutions of Vehicles

Substitutions will be allowed at the discretion of the Society subject to the following conditions:

- a. Full details of the new vehicle must be submitted
- b. The new vehicle must be entered in and be eligible for the same class as the original vehicle.
- c. The Society reserves the right to exclude the substitute vehicle from judging

9. Vehicle Movement on the Showground

No general vehicle movement is allowed on the Showground from 8.30am either day, **but MER vehicles may be allowed entry at the organisers discretion up to 9.00am after which the entry gates will be locked.** Vehicles entered in the Vehicle Rally may leave the Showground **either** under the Stewards' control at 4.30pm for a period of 10 minutes **or** will have to remain until 6.30pm when it is judged that the majority of the public have exited the Showground. For safety reasons no vehicle may leave its parked position in the Rally compound until the Stewards have indicated that it is safe to do so. Exhibitors failing to observe this regulation may be refused entry to subsequent Show Rallies.

10. **Society Membership Subscriptions**
